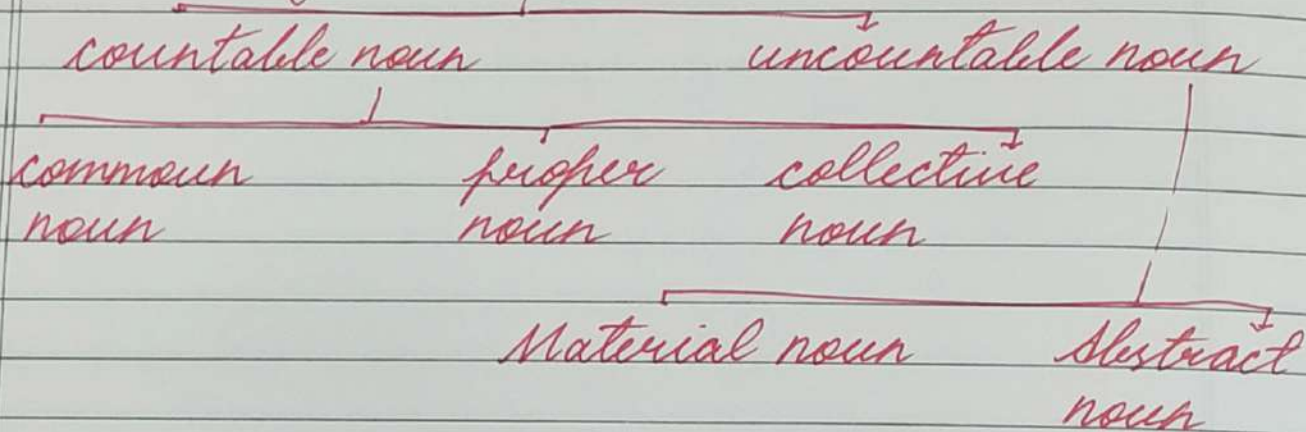

Definition - A noun is the name of person, place, animal or thing.

eg-
person: Mukesh, uncle, aunt.
place: Patna, school, park.
animal: dog, cat, tiger, goat.
thing: door, pen, table, bag.

Kinds of Noun



① Common Noun - A common noun is a name given to every place, person or thing of the same class or kind. ★ It always use to write in small letter.
eg - Common person - man, woman, boy, girl.
Common place - town, village, school.
Common thing - book, table, chair, fan.

eg - Mr. Sen is a teacher in our school.

② Sachin Tendulkar is a great cricketer.

③ Tom loves his pet dog.

② Proper Noun - A proper noun is the name of some particular person or place.

* Proper Nouns are always written in capital letter.

eg- Proper person - Ajit, Neetu, Ravi, Kanya
Proper place - Mumbai,
proper thing - Ramayan, Gita, Duran

③ Collective Noun - The Noun which denotes a group of persons or other creatures and collection of things are called collective noun.

eg- crowd, mob, team, flock, herd, army, jury, family etc
